## The Fine Print (or, Frequently Asked Questions)

**When does the game start and end?** June 1st to August 2nd. **How old do I have to be to play?** You must be entering grades 6 - 12. **How do I register for the game?** Go online to the Art of Summer webpage (<http://www2.fairfieldpubliclibrary.org/sr/>) and begin by setting up your username and password. Then you are ready to start logging and reporting your reading. **Why is the game online?** So you can report your reading 24/7, from anywhere in the world with internet access. You don't have to come to the library to win weekly prizes, but you do have to come to the Finale party for a chance at a Grand Prize. **How many books can a report per week?** As many as you'd like. Keep in mind - since we do a raffle each week, you may want to spread out your reading over the whole summer to improve your chances of winning. **What should go in my book reporting?** Number of pages and a review of the best or worst part of the book (A description. Saying 'the end' or something like that won't count. **Why extra tickets for graphic novels & manga?** Why not? It's called The Art of Summer, after all...
