



## Checking Out eBooks or MP3 Audiobooks for Android Devices

You can use the Library's eBooks on popular mobile devices with Android operating systems. Computer syncing is not required; eBooks can be delivered directly to your device through either the free [OverDrive Media Console](#) app and/or the [Kindle](#) app. You must have a Fairfield Public Library card to download digital books from the library.

### Which app should you use?

For Adobe EPUB books, you need to download the [OverDrive Media Console](#) app. For [Kindle](#) books, you need to download *both* the [OverDrive Media Console](#) app and the [Kindle](#) app. If you download both apps, you will have a larger variety of books to download.

### OverDrive Media Console App instructions (required for Adobe EPUB books and MP3 Audiobooks):

1. Search for and download the [Overdrive Media Console](#) app from your device's app store.
2. Open the app and tap the "Get Books" icon on the screen. Then tap [Add Library](#) and enter **06824** to pull up a list of local libraries. Click on [Fairfield Public Library](#) and tap on the star icon to add this to your favorites list (otherwise you will have to search for this library each time).
3. Tap on the [Fairfield Public Library](#) listing and filter your search under Format by tapping on Adobe EPUB eBook. Browse the library catalog to find a book to checkout.
4. Tap [Borrow](#).
5. Enter your **Fairfield Public Library card number** and tap [Login](#).
6. Tap [Download](#) to get the eBook. If this is your first download, authorize the [OverDrive Media Console](#) app at this time by following the pop-up instructions. Create your Adobe username and password.
7. Your eBook will be downloaded. Click on the [OverDrive](#) icon on your notification bar to access your book, or re-open the [OverDrive Media Console](#) app and tap "Bookshelf." Click on your book to start reading.

### Kindle App instructions:

You must have an Amazon account to download books using the [Kindle](#) app.

### **For Android Tablets:**

1. If not already installed on your device, search and download the [Kindle](#) app from your device's app store. Register your device using your Amazon username and password.
2. If not already installed, search and download the [OverDrive Media Console](#) app from your device's app store per the instructions above, numbers 1 - 2. Authorize the [OverDrive Media Console](#) app at this time by following the pop-up instructions. Create your Adobe username and password.
3. Tap on the [Fairfield Public Library](#) listing and filter your search under Format by tapping on Kindle Book. Browse the library catalog to find a book to checkout. (If Kindle books are not visible in the app search, your device does not support this format for direct downloads.)
4. Tap [Borrow](#).
5. Enter your **Fairfield Public Library card number** and tap [Login](#).
6. Tap [Download](#) and select Kindle Book. Tap [Confirm & Download](#). Amazon's website will automatically open in your browser. You must have an Amazon account. Click on [Get Library Book](#). If you are not already logged in to your Amazon account, it will ask you to log in. Choose which of your Kindle devices you wish to deliver your book to and click [Continue](#).
7. **Thanks!** will appear on your screen meaning your eBook has downloaded. Open the [Kindle](#) app to access your book. Click on your book to start reading.

**All eBooks can be checked out for a maximum period of 14 days. They will automatically be 'returned to the library' from your device at the end of your checkout period. You also have the option of returning a book earlier via the app's menu.**
