

Downloading eBooks: to Nook Color, NookTablet, Nook HD

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- A NOOK Color™, NOOK Tablet™, NOOK® HD, or NOOK® HD+
- A library card
- Wi-Fi access
- An Adobe ID— the **OverDrive** app will prompt you to register for an Adobe ID

1. Download the **OverDrive** app to your NOOK

- Open up the **Shop** section
- Search for **OverDrive**
- Install the app


2. Sign on with your Adobe ID

- When you launch the **OverDrive** app, you will be prompted to create a free Adobe ID if you don't already have one
- Enter your free Adobe ID to authorize the app on your NOOK

3. Inside the **OverDrive** app, find your library

- Tap **Get Books** to switch to the library list
- Tap **Add a Library** to search for your local library
- Tap the ☆ next to a library to add it to your list
- Tap **Fairfield Public Library** on the list to go to the library's mobile site

4. Browse and check out an eBook and/or MP3 audiobook

- Search for eBooks by title, author, genre, or use the Advanced Search function.
- If an eBook is available for immediate checkout, a darkened icon of an open book  will display where the page corner is turned down. If the book is unavailable, this icon will be grayed out.
- When you've found a title, tap **Borrow**.
- Enter your Library Card Number. Tap **Login**.
- Tap **Download EPUB ebook**. The title will load onto your **Bookshelf** within the Overdrive Media Console app.

5. Reading library eBooks

- Open the Overdrive App, select **Bookshelf** and **Tap the eBook** to open it
- All titles have a lending period and will automatically expire from your device when the lending period is up, so there is never a risk of late fees.
