
#### JABARI JUMPS

This story follows a singing girl's fruitless search for a friend in her world, until one night when her song is finally heard by someone who understands (2017).




#### WINDOWS


#### THE STORYBOOK KNIGHT

Ordered by his parents to tame a dragon, a gentle knight who prefers reading to fighting arms himself with a book. (2016)




#### THE RABBIT LISTENED

When Taylor's block castle is destroyed, all the animals think they know just what to do, but only the rabbit quietly listens to how Taylor is feeling (Year)




#### THERE'S A MONSTER IN YOUR BOOK

Encourages the reader to shake, tilt, and wiggle the book to remove the little monster inside, but once it is out, another problem arises. (2017)




#### CREEPLY PAIR OF UNDERWEAR




#### AFTER THE FALL

After falling off the wall, Humpty Dumpty is very afraid of climbing up again, but is determined not to let fear stop him from being close to the birds. (2017)




#### TOAD ON THE ROAD

Illustrations and rhyming text invite the reader to help Toad learn that the road is no place to play. (2017)




#### DANNY MCGEE DRINKS THE SEA

When Danny's sister doubts his boast that he can drink the entire sea, he not only proves he was right, he swallows everything else in sight. (2016)




#### NOBODY'S DUCK
