




BLACK WHITE

Practice counting as a little girl named Flora attempts to keep up as more and more friendly chicks emerge from the nest, in a wordless board book with interactive flaps. (2017)




BEFORE & AFTER




GOOD NIGHT, BABY BEAR

Join Lemur in a game of peek-a-boo at the zoo, and find out who's hiding behind cut-out holes. (2017)




FREIGHT TRAIN

Brief text and illustrations trace the journey of a colorful train as it goes through tunnels, by cities, and over trestles. (1978)




GOSSIE


A mother dog finds eight other animals hiding around the house before finding her lost puppy. Flaps conceal the animals. (1980)




TEN TINY TICKLES




PAT THE BUNNY

Children see a variety of animals, each one a different color, and a teacher looking at them. (1967)




MY VERY FIRST MOTHER GOOSE




IF ANIMALS SAID I LOVE YOU
