

Petra and Calder combine their talents to solve an international art scandal when seemingly unrelated and strange events occur and a precious Vermeer painting disappears. (2004)




HOLD FAST

Winston and his friends enter a puzzle contest to win fifty thousand dollars for their school, but they must also figure out who is trying to keep them from winning. (2009)




THE BOOK THAT PROVES TIME TRAVEL HAPPENS

During time travel, Ambrose and his friends find historical connections between Morse code and ancient Chinese hexagrams. (2015)




UNDER THE EGG




SWINDLE




GHOSTS OF GREENGLASS HOUSE
