

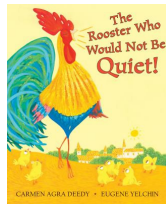

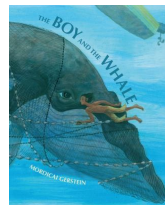


### THE ROOSTER WHO WOULD NOT BE QUIET!

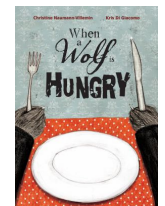
