




Children's Booklist 2022: Books to Start

by Molly Cox



by Jennifer Bové




"Hello, Hedgehog!" Series



by Tracey Hecht



by Lauren Thompson



by Eric Seltzer


Beginning readers will laugh out loud over animals doing silly, unusual, or out-of-this-world things in this delightfully silly series!
