


DJ Funkyfoot : Give Cheese a Chance


Dear Beast

Through a series of letters, Simon, a grumpy and jealous cat, informs Baxter, his boy's new dog, that he is not welcome and should leave at once.




The Bad Guys in The One?!

Confused when the students in Room 26 start whispering about a surprise backwards birthday bash, class pets Humphrey and Og are delighted when they discover that the party is for them.




Jasper & Scruff: The Cafe Competition

by Stuart Gibbs



by Andy Griffiths






