




Readers can help expert clue hunters Dink, Josh and Ruth Rose find the culprit behind the disappearance of a rare amur leopard from the San Diego Zoo.


When his goat assistant is arrested for stealing the golden pickle paperweight, a mystery-solving Venus flytrap is determined to find the real thief.


Judy Moody, Girl Detective






