by Eve L. Ewing




the Makers and find out what really happened to her father.

by Megan Reyes



by Neal Shusterman


When strange things start happening to him, 14-year-old Noah discovers there are mysterious people who want him dead and only his friend Ogden, whose ideas are way out there, can help him.
